Prayer Calendar

SUNDAY	Read Hebrews 5:7–8. What does God want to say to you about prayer? Have you grown weary of praying and not receiving answers? What answers you have received lately, and for what can you give thanks to God? Pray for God to give you hope and faithfulness to pray, and grace to submit and praise him for the answers he gives as your loving Father.
MONDAY	Praise God for his favor in giving a quick answer in the last visa case. Praise him for hearing our prayers for Caspari's ministry, teaching us faithfulness and perseverance in prayer, and encouraging us with answers! We are grateful!
TUESDAY	Pray for the Caspari staff and their families in both Israel and North America. Pray for our leaders, Knut and Alec. Pray for Sanna, who just came to the country and is adjusting and learning Hebrew. Pray for Heidi, who is preparing to return to Israel. Bless all our partners and individual supporters around the world.
WEDNESDAY	Pray for the teacher's training and the work with the Ethiopian congregation in Netanya, and for new leadership training requested by a group of young Ethiopian believers. Pray for completion of the youth book, setting up the new Caspari website, and finalizing the library system.
THURSDAY	Keep on praying for our mini Bible school in Ashkelon for a local congregation. Pray for the planning of the Russian-language Shabbat school seminar in Haifa and the singles event in Jerusalem in March.
FRIDAY	Pray faithfully for justice and order in the Middle East. Pray for the elections and establishment of democracy in different countries. Pray for peace and safety for Christians in the area and for security in Israel.
SATURDAY	Pray for the body of Messiah in Israel to grow in love, faith, and numbers! Ask God to call believers in Yeshua to build and work for the unity of the body of Yeshua. Bless spiritual leaders and pray that God will give them special wisdom.
